Healing in His Wings

An Anointing that Will Open the Heavens Regional Director David Hauser, Pasadena, CA USA



There is a host of articles and books that are written on this subject. When one follows those who carry an anointing for healing I have often wanted to ask them how they received it. It is interesting that there are many explanations on how it was acquired. All of us should want to experience an anointing that will set the captive free, will cause people to cry out, "what must I do to be saved?" or see a release of signs and wonders. I would like to share a quality of anointing that the Scripture says is found in the cluster. Isaiah 65:8

Unity has always been important to me, and to the International Association of Healing Rooms. I remember about 15 years ago when my wife and I shared a common vision while ministering in Lima Peru. We had a vision of a Rodeo; a bull had been release with a cowboy in quick pursuit. He threw his rope around the bull's neck and proceeded to jump off his horse. He grabbed the bull by its head, flipped it on its back and tied it legs. I asked the Lord, "What does all this mean?" I

then heard God say, "If I can turn the head the body will follow." Since that time I have known that God wanted to minister to leadership in such a way that they would cry out for unity. That is why I love the IAHR because there is such a wonderful desire to see Unity in the Body of Christ. Rick Taylor once told me there are enough sick people to go around, and to bless other ministries in the Body of Christ even when they don't want to be with us. Have you ever wondered why Unity is so important? Maybe the reason is "*that the world may know...*" John 17:23, or possibly because God said He would make it a place



of commanded blessing. Psalm 133:3 We call this a Love Anointing!

We all resonate at times with different frequencies, the question must be asked, "What is God's frequency?" The enemy often comes to say something that is familiar but not quite true. If we walk in the Spirit we will know what He is saying. *Genesis 3:1*

There are over 100 varieties of olive trees. A friend of mine shared with me that not all oil is alive. Some oil has a 4-star rating. To have high quality oil one must have a good root system and good soil. Olive trees prefer hills for growing rather than flat ground. There has always been a call to the Church to come up to the heavenly places. Olive trees have 4 distinct seasons. We have seasons in our lives, too. There is one very important fact and that is that once the olives have been picked, you have about 24 hours to press and retrieve the oil, or it can spoil. Anointing should be a daily experience. Yesterday's oil is never as good as today's oil. In order to have enough oil you need a lot of wind, and I mean <u>a lot</u> of wind as bees are not the principle source of pollination!!!! Finally what is critical for anointing, or good oil, is you need lots of variety of olive trees which brings the cross pollination.

The Body of Christ coming together mixed with the three spices of prayer, worship and thanksgiving, will produce more and more of the Kingdom of God."

Even so come Lord Jesus!

The Lord recently sent a little messenger to our Headquarters facility in the form of a butterfly, a beautiful Swallowtail. At first he appeared to be lifeless lying on the floor. But when picked up, he moved. He was *ALIVE*!

He was immediately taken to the office of our receptionist, who then placed him in a nearby plant, while she researched how to feed him. Sugar water it was, so she set about to care for him throughout the week.

When the weekend approached, she knew she had to take him home to keep him warm, fed and safe. After further research, she then prepared a terrarium with plants, sticks and rocks, to

create a habitat that was familiar to him. Using a Q-tip soaked in sugar water, she would gently hold him on her finger as he wrapped his proboscis (that is the long "nose" that extends like a drinking straw when the butterfly feeds) around the cotton tip, making it appear that he was feeding on a flower. While feeding, he would rest his legs on her finger.

Each night when she came through the door, the dog would bark, the parakeets would sing and chirp and the little butterfly would flutter his wings, as though welcoming her home. The Lord had clearly entrusted the care of this little fellow to a woman whose heart was filled with gentle compassion and a nurturing spirit.

As the days passed, she became aware that this little guy needed a name, so she asked the Lord what that name should be. He told her it was "Max." How fitting it was, because Max was yellow and black. Prophetically speaking, yellow means light of illumination. Research had shown her that his days on earth were numbered and he was approaching the time when he would die, but now that he was named, she knew that it was okay for him to go. Shortly thereafter, Max did indeed die.

So what's the moral of this story, you may ask. There is most always a spiritual truth associated with a physical reality, and clearly that is true in this case.

First, **Matt. 6:22** says, "the eye is the lamp of the body; so then if your eye is clear, your whole body will be full of light." In the secular translation of almost all modern languages, "Max" means great or greatest. This little butterfly, seemingly so helpless, one could say the least, came to teach us some great lessons. We should not fear seeming weak because God's strength allows and empowers us to fulfill our destiny with joy and greatness.

And corporately perhaps we, at the Healing Rooms, are the Q-tip for the wounded butterflies of the world. We are soaked in "sugar water", the Word of God and His Holy Spirit, which restores life to the weary. We are called to be a light in a dark world, the salt of the earth, spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ, the hope of Glory. When people walk through the doors of our Healing Rooms broken, sick, crippled, frightened, and oftentimes hopeless, they enter into an atmosphere of healing, light, truth, hope and freedom. It is then that they often begin to drink from that well of living water and their spirits and bodies are touched by the gentle hand of our loving Lord as they experience healing and restoration to abundant life.

When they have a taste of the Word of God and experience the lovingkindness of Jesus Christ through the power of His Holy Spirit, it causes them to thirst for more of Him. Yet in their brokenness, though they are clinging to the hope of life and truth, they oftentimes need to "rest" their wearied souls on the "fingers" of those praying in faith, believing in the miracle working power of God in their lives. Gentle compassion and nurturing spirits are what they cling to, until they are strong enough to reach up and take hold of the hand of the Promise of the Father.

UKRAINE



God has been opening doors into other nations and countries for Ukraine's National Advisors, Dmytro Smorzh and Irina Belova-Smorzh to spread the vision of Healing Rooms. The interest for Healing Rooms Ministries is growing among the pastors of different churches throughout Ukraine. It is so exciting to see.

In 2016 we will be holding presentations, "basics" seminars, on Healing Rooms Ministries in the Ukrainian cities of Mariupol (on the border of anti-terrorist operation), Odessa, Lvov, Kremenchug.

The interest for Healing Rooms Ministries is growing even among the Baptist churches that traditionally in Ukraine do not believe in the fullness of God's Will to heal a person (usually they pray: "Thy will be done").

We feel God is sending us into another nations and countries to spread the vision of IAHR. After the very intense mission trip to Germany and Switzerland in April (in 10 different cities), we will be promoting Healing Rooms and teaching the "basics" in Armenia in April; then in May we will be in Kaliningrad (Russia). The rest of the year will be busy with the trips we have planned to Tashkent (Uzbekistan), Latvia, St. Petersburg, Sochi, Samara (Russia).

We are excited to also be preparing for our first big conference of Healing Rooms ministers from Eastern Europe in September.

FRANCE

Mourad and Brigitte Ziani are our National Directors to France. Mourad is regularly invited to give training sessions and open new Healing Rooms throughout the nation. More and more churches are rediscovering what the Bible says about healing.

There are now more than 20 Healing Rooms dotted around the nation. Here are some recent testimonies from some of the French Healing Rooms:

A 14-year-old girl who arrived with one leg longer than the other testified, "My right knee is healed and my legs are now the same length – thank you, Father!"

A young woman came for prayer for pain and hypersensitivity as a result of

a cancer the Lord had healed 12 years earlier. She said, "God took away my pain ... It hardly hurts at all anymore!"

A woman in her sixties came for prayer for Morton's Neuroma which was causing her a lot of pain. She testified, "I was supposed to have an operation but thanks to God, the pain has significantly decreased and I don't need the operation anymore." After prayer, she was able to dance around the room and run down the stairs!

An older man with a serious respiratory problem came and was quite astonished when God healed him. He said, "I don't know what God did, but I can breathe normally now!"

We hope you are encouraged by what the Lord is doing in this nation, where the spiritual climate seems to be changing and people are more open to the gospel after the recent tragic events.



CANADA

This year several Directors were ordained under IAHR at Canada's 2nd Annual National Healing Conference. It was a privilege to publicly honour and acknowledge their leadership and servant hearts. New Healing Rooms have been birthed in the provinces of Nova Scotia, British Columbia and Ontario. Ontario and British Columbia both held their second annual provincial Healing Rooms Convention, each welcoming over 100 active Healing Rooms

volunteers. Our prayer is for an annual convention in each province. The purpose of provincial conventions is to unite, encourage and strengthening the directors and volunteers, as well as address common questions from

Healing Rooms across the country. This year in Ontario we discussed how to minister the Father's unconditional love to clients living an LGBT lifestyle and clients who present with suicidal thoughts. Canada has witnessed deliverance in the following areas (to name a few!): addictions, self-mutilation, dissociative identity disorder, muscular sclerosis, cancer, Hepatitis C, scoliosis, depressions and anxiety!

In **Mexico**, God has put in the heart of a businessman in the city of Victoria, Tamaulipas to pledge physical buildings so that Healing Rooms can be opened in every neighborhood in the city. Praise Jesus! While in **Peru**, two of our Directors are on the verge of obtaining an hour of Christian T.V. programming. The idea is to have Healing Rooms Peru with a half hour T.V. show promoting the Healing Rooms Ministry throughout the city. What an opportunity and blessing this will be to the Healing Rooms Ministries.

God is opening the doors to **Brazil.** In May 2016, we have an invitation to go to Sao Paulo, Brazil. A group of churches known as "Bola de Nieve" are inviting the Healing Rooms to cast the vision in three cities and to do a training in establishing the Healing Rooms Ministries in their churches.

We have received information about interest in opening Healing Rooms in **Guatemala.** We are in the early stage of these communications and will continue pursuing the possibility to bring Healing Rooms to this country. USA—STATE DIRECTORS

Healing Rooms of the Northern Plains—Bismarck, North Dakota

We always want our area to know that we are here for the community and here for other ministries, too. On January 16th the Healing Rooms of the Northern Plains participated in the "Big Event," a carnival for the whole family put on by Child Evangelism. It was all free. There are carnival games, our prayer

tent for free prayer, "e" tents to hear a story about Jesus, face painting, and big inflatables to go on. It is a great way to have family fun, get out of the cold, and be touched by Jesus!

This year Child Evangelism had a fun competition for the carnival booths called "Battle of the Booths." We were to dress up like action figures.



We were angels (flames of fire); and our booth had the title

"God Will Light Your Spirit." It was such fun! Families or individuals come to get a 'blessing' – or short prayer of encouragement. Some ask for more and, of course, we do that, too. We had three teams going at all times.

In the course of 3 hours we prayed for 465 people! AND we won the Battle of the Booths! We encourage all Healing Rooms to stretch themselves and purchase a small arts/craft tent, be a part of a community event – county fair – city celebration, pray for people and let God's love shine! We participate in the community along with our regular Healing Rooms hours; it puts us OUT there – and it is so fulfilling.

Staying True to the IAHR Model

As State Directors, my husband and I have had the privilege of helping others establish IAHR Healing Rooms in their cities, and also doing IAHR retraining weekends for the already established Healing Rooms in our state.

It is important that we are always sharpening our skills. We are no different than a professional baseball team that has spring training each year to go over the basics of their game. No matter how seasoned a baseball player is, or how long they have been playing the game, you will still find them on the practice field going over the fundamentals of their game...batting, running bases, catching ground and fly balls, hand signals, etc.

Unfortunately, not every Healing Rooms that IAHR has established has continued to go over the fundamentals of our model on a regular basis. We suggest you do this yearly. In our travels, we have noticed a major difference in the empowerment of the Healing Rooms that stay true to the IAHR prayer model vs the Healing Rooms that have drifted off course from the IAHR prayer model. All Healing Rooms were having a degree of success. But, the Healing Rooms that were staying true to the model were having greater success in their Rooms, carrying a stronger healing and miracle anointing, because they were flowing in a greater love and unity anointing then those Healing Rooms that have drifted away from the model.

We also found, behind the scenes of those Healing Rooms that have drifted away from the model,

the Directors were frustrated and many times they were having discord among their team, not even realizing why.

SO WHY IS THIS? Losing sight of the fact that unity is a major key of importance in our Healing Rooms; or, realizing it, but not knowing how to get back to the unity that they once experienced among their Healing Rooms team. The IAHR prayer model teaches us to hookup and flow as <u>one unit</u> while still being able to flow within our individual gifting. (*Matt. 18:18, 19*)

If we want to become the body of Christ carrying His full measure (*Eph. 1:22, 23 AMP*), the same measure that Christ carried while He was on this earth, we need to learn to begin to think and move interdependently with one another, as one unit. <u>No independent thinkers</u>. If we are thinking independently while ministering in the prayer rooms, we are not flowing totally with what the Holy Spirit wants to do and we miss the fullness of Christ's healing expression.

John 15:5, 7 says, "*He (Jesus) is the vine and we are the branches.*" The word *branches* is plural. When we connect together to the vine (Jesus), in our prayer model, we are receiving the same source of life, at the same time, through communion with the Holy Spirit and with each other...flowing as one unit, therefore, creating a flow of His expression of love and unity. Jesus says when we position ourselves in this manner, "we can ask what we desire and it will be done for us, by this My Father is glorified."

Psalm 133:2, 3 says that when we are dwelling together in unity it is like precious oil (ointment) and it is like the dew of Hermon. **Deut. 33:13** states that the precious gifts of Heaven come from the dew. In other words, when we are flowing as one unit, interdependently, it draws the anointing into the atmosphere like dew. What happens when dew comes down? You get wet with the presence of God; God commands and releases His precious gifts from Heaven into our midst. Healings and Miracles happen!

Psalm 133:1 says, "*Behold how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!*" That word *behold* means to hold attention to, hold in view, keep hold of. Don't forget about what you are seeing, keep it in your view.

This verse is warning us that unity is something that needs to be practiced, protected, and guarded, and it is also something of which we can lose hold.

Our IAHR prayer model helps us stay focused and keep guard of unity in our Healing Rooms. Stay true to the IAHR prayer model. Don't allow the enemy to get a foothold in your Healing Rooms by coming in and destroying the unity of your team, thus weakening the anointing in your Healing Rooms.

We are here for you! Let's stay networked together by calling your State, Regional, and National Directors to come and do a retraining and refreshing weekend for you and your Healing Rooms team.



USA, KENTUCKY

In 2011, New Life Church Healing Room Director Amanda Atkinson, said she has documented proof that the Lord healed her from Crohn's disease, which has no medical cure, after attending a Tuesday night prayer service at New Life.

She went to her scheduled doctor's appointment on that following Thursday and Atkinson said her doctor couldn't believe what he saw. "My doctor's exact words were 'I don't understand. It's a miracle. It looks like you have a brand new colon. I can't find any disease anywhere,' and I had been seeing that same doctor for years," Atkinson said.

Atkinson was sick for 10 years and had to take leave from work because she couldn't function. After being healed, she knew she had to share her miraculous experience with others. "When you've experienced a transformation of something like that, when you see the Lord, when you feel the love, you can't keep that inside," Atkinson said. "That's one of the things I love about Healing Rooms is we get a chance to express that love, His love, to other people."

Healing Rooms Ministries is an international organization reopened in 1999 by International Director Cal Pierce in Spokane, Wash., based on the Healing Rooms of John G. Lake. Lake's ministry opened in the same location 80 years ago.

Real Life Church Healing Rooms Co-Director Douglas Menck said the ministry expands across several different churches and denominations to make up one body in Christ. "When you look at your body, you can name its parts. Well, it's the same thing in the church world, it doesn't matter the denomination," Menck said.

"Believers come together and we see God do miraculous things." There are around 3,000 Healing Rooms in 75 nations, with two in Bowling Green and 13 in Kentucky overall. New Life is accepting appointments only at this time, but will soon have regular hours, Atkinson said. Real Life Healing Rooms is open to the public from 7 to 8:30 pm every Tuesday.



Real Life Healing Rooms Co-Director Suzy Menck said the

difference between Healing Rooms and going to church and receiving prayer is the limitation of time you can spend on an individual. "This way with Healing Rooms (programs), it's concentrated prayer. We spend about 20 minutes with you praying for your specific needs whether they be physical, mental, emotional, financial, whatever your need is we can focus and just spend our undivided attention right on that one person," Suzy Menck said.

Also, some people come to a Healing Room that will never go to a church service and ask for prayer, Suzy Menck said. The session is confidential, and the healing teams also educate and give advice to participants on biblical truths to equip them for the future as well, Atkinson said.

The first thing a person interested in receiving prayers from the haling team would do is walk in and fill out a form and state what they're wanting prayers for. Then, the healing team will pray over the form, and a group of three will go into a room and pray together before bringing the person into the room with them. After prayer, the team will look at the form and see what was written and pray over the person and explain what the Holy Spirit has revealed to them through prayer.

All healing team members receive specialized training at one of the training sessions in Madisonville, (continued on page 10) (continued from page 9)

Kentucky hosted three times a year with Regional Directors Rush and Barbie Hunt. Barbie Hunt said the next free training session is on the first weekend in February with 45 minutes teachings, prayer and lots of practice.



"Many Christians believe in healing, but they've never see it," Barbie

Hunt said. The training "is hands-on, and we teach a little bit and then we practice a lot." She said Healing Rooms' philosophy gives an opportunity to pray for the sick, people who are hurting or needing someone to help them in anyway. It gives a safe, peaceful and comfortable environment to receive prayer.

"We enable Christians who want to pray for the sick to come together and pray. We have a model called the five step prayer model, and we have a lot of people who just want to be more comfortable praying for the sick," Barbie Hunt said. The model consists of interviewing, listening, asking questions, praying and looking to see if anything has changed, Hunt said.

"The number one thing that we want people to understand is when they come to Healing Rooms, it's God's love. How much He loves them and hears them. Everything else to me is bonus. When you experience God's love, truly, truly experience it, it's life changing," Suzy Menck said.

Testimonies...If God's done it for one, He'll do it for you!

<u>Sunnyvale, CA - USA</u> — Jocelin—Every time Jaden goes to the Healing Rooms, his following therapies seem to be very, very effective; it's almost like he has a developmental growth spurt! The first couple of times in the summer it seemed like he really started to improve his eye contact and looking at our face, which is very important if you're trying to learn how to make new sounds since you have to look at the mouth. Ever since he has really made an effort to look at our mouths and imitate if we ask him to look at us, whereas before it was a huge struggle, so he's slowly been gaining a new sound here and there.

In December, I felt like he started to increase his sounds significantly. His speech therapist was so impressed during his last session because he was making almost all vowel sounds as well as some consonant vowel combinations (baa, boo, etc.) some of which she heard for the very first time. He improved in communication too, asking for a lot more things, even though mostly by gesture or pointing, or shaking his head when he doesn't want something.

He also improved socially this past month. Before he would take our hand to lead us to another room so that we could be "present" with him, but then he would play by himself with his toys; now he sometimes actually asks us to join in his play. For example, he'll take my hand wanting me to sit down with him to help him push his trains along the track, or he'll initiate jumping games with one of us on the trampoline where he wants one of us to hold his hand while he jumps (before we would usually have to be the one to initiate). I know many of these things seem like simple things which many parents might take for granted that their kid should be able to learn easily, but believe me these are HUGE milestones for a child on the spectrum.

Praise God for all of the ways God is working in Jaden's life!

<u>Washington DC—USA</u> The miracle occurred when a woman with ALS who was wheelchair bound was carried down the steps and into the Healing Rooms by the men on the teams. As the team prayed, they broke off the spiritual affliction caused by masonry. They prayed for healing. The woman who could not walk and was carried in while in her wheelchair, rose up from her wheelchair and walked out...up the stairs on her way home while her family wept and rejoiced.

<u>Camarillo, CA—USA</u>—Gayner Bemisdarfer—On 12/24/2013 we received a phone call from our daughter Christina. She said, "Mom, I'm pregnant." This was great news, because a year before she had been told she could never have a baby.

One month later, however, on January 18, 2014, I received another phone call from my daughter. She said, "Mom, I'm in the hospital the doctors say I'm losing my baby". Christina was only 4 and half months into the pregnancy. I would like to be able to tell you my faith kicked in but that wasn't the case. I called our pastor; he was on his way to San Diego. He prayed with me and said, "Don't let your faith waver." Something snapped in my spirit and I thought, "That is right!"

Time for battle! I called the Camarillo Healing Rooms, of which I have been a member for seven years. And I called the church prayer chain and all the seasoned intercessors I knew and trusted. For months they joined our family in the prayer of faith.

Our daughter was in the hospital trying to keep her baby and for eight days we battled. Then the baby was born, Grace Ivy, 1 pound 10 ounces and 12 inches long at Marquette Neonatal Intensive Care. Our daughter called and said, "Mom, the doctors say Grace will not live." "No, I said! The Lord says, 'He breathes life and gives strength to the bones'." Then, the doctors spoke many things over Grace: "Her lungs are not developing; she would be blind from oxygen; her heart would not be able to sustain her..." On and on it went. But, GOD! The Lord is the giver of life and He is our sustainer.

Finally a turn around! After months of praying and contending, a bright light shines in the darkness. Baby Grace is starting to thrive. Her lungs were starting to develop and heart was getting stronger. But, then another negative report from the doctors came saying that Grace's kidneys were failing. Back to war we went in prayer. As a result, the kidneys were healed.

Another doctor's report came a month before her release date: "She is blind." Man, about this time I was so excited about what the Lord was doing that I knew it was just another mountain to be taken. Because of this last report, Grace was taken to a special hospital in Ann Arbor Michigan, hundreds of miles from our daughter's home. And our daughter was not allowed to go with Grace. So, my daughter and I prayed together 3 or 4 times a day, everyday.

Then, the doctor's report comes: "Oops! We made a mistake. Grace is not blind. She sees perfectly." Back to Marquette where Grace stayed until May 6, 2014, which was not only her original due date but the date she was released from the hospital to her parents. Now, she is a perfect and happy baby girl! The doctors can't understand why she is thriving and not having some major issues. Our daughter tells them, "The Lord healed my baby".

However, just before Thanksgiving 2015 this past year, Christina was given another bad report. Grace was having some mental difficulties. So back to war we go in prayer. I crafted a "Sozo" prayer. My daughter and I prayed it together over the phone, than my daughter laid her hands (continued on page 12) (continued from page 11)

on Grace's head. The next day Grace had an amazing deliverance and she was completely healed. The doctors are baffled and our daughter told them, "My mom and I prayed, and God healed Grace. What's so hard to understand about that?"

It may seem you are working at those mountains with a pick and ax, but eventually the mountains must come down. Just keep at it until you see the result.

I imagined a room full of sick and physically injured people looking for healing from incurable diseases and life threatening injuries. It feels silly to say now, but I felt inadequate. I was there with a broken heart and desperately pleading for God to give us a third child. After all we had been through to get our boys I felt greedy asking for another. But as much as I prayed and told people that if two was our number I could accept that, I was a hypocrite. Because deep down in my soul, in my mama heart I couldn't accept it. I struggled whether that was me or the Lord. I guess more than anything I just wanted an answer and I wanted my joy back.

When it was my turn, I sat down in this small circle of women. I wanted to run out the door, apologizing I had made a mistake and didn't really need help. But instead, God kept me firmly planted in my chair while I shared my story through tears of shame to three complete strangers.

The next thing that happened was the most supernatural experience I had ever encountered. After I stopped talking, each woman in the circle began taking turns praying. Some sat quietly while others prayed over me. Some quietly spoke with God on my behalf while they waited their turn to pray over me. I can't remember how long this went on for. I just remember sitting, my eyes closed, and the tears flowing freely without apology. I remember feeling the presence of God more fully then I have ever felt before. It was as if only God and I were in the room and His voice could be heard through the disguise of each woman's voice. It was their voices but His words.

Once we were done, I wiped my tears, accepted hugs from each woman in the circle, and gathered my boys to leave. I remember walking out to the parking lot, getting in my van and feeling lighter then I had in months. The next few weeks I processed my experience. I felt God's healing in my heart, my joy for life was returning. My anger and bitterness had been replaced with appreciation and joy for the gifts God was blessing my family with rather than viewing life through a lens of resentment and fear.

I was seeing myself through God's eyes again, not my own. I knew that God had healed me, I didn't know if I would have another baby again, but I knew I was no longer defining my worth by my ability to have more children. And that's what I ultimately needed healing from.

Today as I write this testimony I am 9 months pregnant, and in just a few short weeks my husband and I will welcome our 3rd son into the world. We can often question God's timing in our life, we are impatient. Waiting for what we think we need or want can be difficult. But one of the many lessons God has taught me through difficult journeys of receiving each of my sons is the power in His timing. The refining process of our faith can be a painful thing, but when we walk out the other side the beauty and wisdom He gives us is more majestic and more powerful than anything we can ever imagine. - Emily Florian




